




GREENWOOD GRAVEL GRIND - LAST SATURDAY IN APRIL

The newest and most exciting event, this adventure cycling ride takes cyclists of all skill levels from the flatland of the Delta into the beautiful hills of Carroll County. Get off the highway and cycle the backroads and enjoy some of the most beautiful scenery you'll ever see. Distances of 30 and 62 miles available.

The HOTTEST trend in cycling is growing rapidly. 2019 was the first year for this event in Greenwood, and the demand is already growing for expansion of this event. The attendance ratio was about 5% local and the remainder was statewide and out-of-state. This event is promoted heavily in Mississippi, Alabama and Arkansas via targeted digital geo-marketing, social media and promotion to specialized cycling groups throughout the region.
